PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Traveling Tree House is a mobile learning center that provides FREE summer learning opportunities for local children. At each visit kids experience 75 minutes of reading, crafts, and activities. A snack and gently used book, of their choice, is sent home with them to keep after each visit. Tree House teachers use AMAZE, literacy based, anti bias curriculum.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- The Tree House stops at 11 designated locations within Douglas County
- Program lasts for 10 weeks and is designed for children ages 4-11
- No pre registration is required to attend
